Affidavit

- 1 It is established beyond any doubt that Natural immunity is robust and long lasting and is far superior to vaccine induced immunity.
- 2 A vast majority of the Indian population has already been exposed to the virus (approx 80%) also cuts down the risk of infection by natural immunity.
- 3 Taking a vaccine is an individual choice and is voluntary as per MOHFW.
- 4 The pandemic in India is almost over and the third wave was also quite mild with very little hospitalizations.
- 5 The global evidence clearly demonstrates that vaccine is unable to prevent infection and does not help in cutting transmission.



- 6 Vaccinations may result in adverse events including death of the vaccinated individual. Many such instances in thousands have already been reported.
- 7 Mandating vaccine for citizens in the current situation is not unnecessary but also does not provide any additional benefit in view of points given in above paragraphs.
- 8 Taking a vaccine is an Individual choice and is voluntary as per MOHFW and any restriction of personal freedom or discrimination based upon vaccination status is unjustified.
- 9 The covid-19 disease is a respiratory virus causing flu like symptoms with survival of 99.9% and more and thus does not merit disproportionate measures.

Hence this affidavit.


